



Award Criteria

PHARMACIST OF THE YEAR AWARD

The pharmacist being nominated for this award must be a current member of USHP. The pharmacist, in a staff or supervisory position, must demonstrate a commitment to the profession of pharmacy through exemplary working relationships with healthcare professionals, innovative pharmacy practice and the assurance of safe and rational drug therapy.

NEW PRACTITIONER PHARMACIST OF THE YEAR AWARD

The pharmacist being nominated for this award must be a current member of USHP. The pharmacist, has been in practice 5 years or less (after graduation and residency) and must demonstrate a commitment to the profession of pharmacy through exemplary working relationships with healthcare professionals, and particularly innovative pharmacy practice and the assurance of safe and rational drug therapy.

PHARMACY INTERN OF THE YEAR AWARD

The pharmacy intern being nominated for this award must be a current member of USHP. The nominee must demonstrate active participation in USHP and interest in institutional pharmacy practice through research or other activities.

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN OF THE YEAR AWARD

The pharmacy technician being nominated for this award must be a current member of USHP. The pharmacy technician must demonstrate exemplary accomplishments which foster the advancement of pharmaceutical care in institutional pharmacy practice.

PHARMACEUTICAL CARE PRACTICE AWARD

The director or head of the group being nominated for this award must be a current member of USHP. This group demonstrates innovative practice encompassing the concept of pharmaceutical care in a collaborative, professional environment.
